GENERAL

The Daniil Pashkoff Prize 2012 (*hereafter 'DPP 2012'*) is organised and sponsored by *Writers Ink. e.V.* **The DPP 2012 is a competition solely for those whose native language is not English.**

Poetry: 19+under Prose: 19+under

Poetry: 20+older Prose: 20+older

Jury members are not eligible to enter.

- Entries must be received by midnight, January 31, 2012.
- Entrants may submit a short story between 1,000 and 1,400 words in length, and/or a poem or collection of poems of at least 30 lines but no more than 100 lines.
- All work submitted for consideration must be the entrant's own original writing, and should not have appeared in print, on a website (*including blogs and social networking sites*) or have been broadcast, or submitted for publication or consideration elsewhere, for the duration of the Daniil Pashkoff Prize (*which is deemed to begin on the date of entry and end on Friday, June 1, 2012*). Any work having appeared in print or on a website will be disqualified.
- All work must be word processed and submitted via email.
- Entries must consist of two separate WORD documents attached to one email: the first document should contain the entry without the author's name, the second, the title of the piece of writing, the author's contact details and a short biography. Both documents must state the title of the piece of writing clearly.
- Entries will be confirmed, assigned a number and made anonymous upon receipt. Judges will not be privy to entrants' names during the reading and judging process. Names will be reattributed to entries only after the winners have been decided.
- *Writers Ink. e.V.* reserves the right to disqualify any entry if there are reasonable grounds to believe that the entrant has breached any of these terms and conditions or made a false declaration on the entry form.
- *Writers Ink. e.V.* will act in accordance with current German data protection legislation regarding your personal data.

JUDGING AND SELECTION

- Judging panels will select a short-list of entrants and, from that list, select the winners. The judges' decisions are final. *Writers Ink. e.V.* reserves the right to change the panel of judges without notice.
- Short-listed entrants will be notified by April 15 and asked to confirm by May 1, 2012. If a short-listed entrant is unable to attend the ceremony, he or she may send a representative on his or her behalf.

COPYRIGHT

- The copyright for each text submitted remains with the author. Entrants grant *Writers Ink. e.V.* a non-exclusive, worldwide licence over each entry submitted. Selected pieces will be printed in a publication *Writers Ink. e.V.* in cooperation with Westermann Verlag and may appear in electronic format on the *Writers Ink. e.V.* website, or in other electronic forms.
